IT'S POOL SEASON

Enjoy more pool seating space with our extended patio, and of course, *remember to always practice social distancing*. There is hand sanitizer available as well. **Please notice the updated pool rules**:

Pool Hours: 10am-9pm

Social distancing rules

- 1. Practice social distancing.
- 2. Maximum 75% of occupancy (30).
- 3. Please use available hand sanitizer.

15 & younger must be accompanied by an adult at least 18 years. 16 years & older may swim unaccompanied. Hawthorne Place pool is for resident use only.

- 1. Shower before entering pool.
- 2. Any person with an open wound or communicable disease is prohibited from the pool.
- 3. Swimming alone is prohibited.
- 4. Running and rough play are prohibited in and around the pool.
- 5. No cut-off.
- 6. Excess body lotions should be removed prior to entering the water.
- 7. Glassware and bottles are not permitted in the pool area.
- 8. Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
- 9. "Swimming" diapers are required on all non-potty trained children.
- 10. Guests must be accompanied by a Hawthorne Place resident.
- 11. Hawthorne Place Owners Association is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 12. Trespassing after pool hours is a punishable offence.
- 13. You must bring your issued key fob to gain entry.
- 14. No smoking in the pool area.
- 15. Hawthorne Place resident is responsible for the actions of guests.
